CONCOURSE WELCOMES

We would like to welcome Theodore “Nick” Drosakis to Concourse Office Park. Nick is the new Security Director and is very glad to be here. PARKING PERMIT PROCEDURES

A new parking program will be in place effective May 1, 2019. The parking decks for the King and Queen towers will require a permit. The permits are free to Building Five and Six tenants. The permits are to be installed on the lower front left (driver’s side) on the interior of the windshield. The permit allows parking on all levels, in any space EXCEPT those spaces marked for visitors, handicap spaces, or spaces marked as “RESERVED.”

There will be an outside parking management company monitoring the decks throughout the day. They will be looking at vehicles illegally parked (those parked in handicap spaces without proper handicap identification, vehicles with a permit parked in a visitor space, or vehicles improperly parked in reserved spaces), vehicles taking more than one space, oversized vehicles in compact car spaces, or vehicles that do not have a permit. Violations could result in the vehicle being booted.

Signage will be installed stating the parking decks are by permit only. We will have a designated “VISITOR” parking area within the deck for visitors to Concourse Five and Six who will need parking for longer than 2 hours. The 1-hour Visitor Parking in the open lot and the 2-hour Visitor Parking spaces within the decks will remain the same.
